5. Interview:

- ♦ The interview will be conducted in both English and Cantonese. The interview will test students' language proficiency, knowledge of Mathematics and Science and critical thinking skills, etc.
- ♦ NO makeup interviews will be arranged for latecomers or absentees.
- 6. Release of results:
 - ♦ Parents of successful applicants of their children's inclusion in the Successful Lists for Discretionary Places will be notified by letter and phone on <u>31 March 2025 (Monday)</u>.
 Parents of successful applicants, who are registered as SSPA e-Platform users, can view the notifications in the SSPA e-Platform.
 - All participating students will receive the SSPA allocation results (including results at the Discretionary Places and Central Allocation stages) on <u>8 July 2025 (Tuesday)</u>.
