### **♥ Mental Health Week ♥**

Our Mental Health Week was organized from 11 November to 15 November, 2024. This event aimed to promote mental well-being among students through various informative activities.

On 11 November, students visited the game booths and exhibitions organized by the NGO "Open Up". This session provided insight into mental health topics in an engaging manner. Through the booth activities, students learned about negative emotions and gained a preliminary understanding of how to manage them.

On 12 November, a lunchtime program was held at the covered playground, hosted by the social workers and the Guidance Committee. This event focused on mental health awareness, with students enjoying tea prepared by the social workers.

On 13 November, three themed workshops were conducted in the classrooms for S1, S4, and S5 students. S1 students explored understanding emotions, S4 students learned stress management techniques, and S5 students participated in a five senses exercise designed to enhance mindfulness and relaxation. On the same day, a session titled "Stress Less, Cook More: Cook Your Way to Relaxation" was held in the STEM Room for S4 and S5 students, emphasizing the therapeutic benefits of cooking.

Throughout the week, there were sessions on relaxation tips, stretching exercises, and the importance of sleep, aimed at enhancing student awareness of the 4Rs. Mental Health Week provided an opportunity for students to learn valuable skills, gain new insight, and participate in activities supporting mental wellness.

The annual Careers Expo, a vibrant event connecting alumni from diverse career fields with current students, took place on 9 November 2024. The occasion provided a platform for sharing experiences and insights. The event included an informative session on JUPAS admissions, engaging alumni discussions, and experiential learning opportunities, such as simulations of the HKDSE result release process and mock admission interviews.

The first session featured a talk on JUPAS Strategies led by Tai Hang Youth Centre, aimed at providing senior students and their parents with information about further education. Attendees learned about the JUPAS mechanism and multiple pathways for further education.

Second, alumni conducted interactive sessions representing their respective industries, ranging from technology and healthcare to arts and entrepreneurship. They engaged with students through presentations, Q&A sessions, and one-on-one discussions, providing invaluable knowledge about the latest trends and demands in their fields.

In the third session, the Mock HKDSE Results Release Day Workshop allowed students to gain practical insight into the admission process of higher education institutions. Secondary Six students could experience the emotions and challenges associated with receiving their exam results, while the mock admission interviews provided a supportive setting for students to practise their interview skills. These hands-on experiences empowered students to build confidence and improve communication skills.

Many alumni returned not only to share their professional journeys but also to inspire and guide our next generation of leaders. Their willingness to pass the baton highlighted their deep commitment to the school. In this exchange, current students took the initiative to learn and explore, embracing the wisdom and experiences shared by those who blazed the trails before them. 


# Aunique experience of cultural andintellectualexchange

On 22 November 2024, our school organized the STGSS Experience Day with multi-faceted programmes in the domains of STEM, AI, sports, and arts for ten primary schools comprising almost 300 students. The exhilaration of our House Cheering team served as an energy-booster for the visitors, kick-starting their fun-filled day with thunderous cheering. The primary students then partook in a series of engaging activities simultaneously, from marveling at dazzling music performances and to immersing themselves in Chinese melodic rhythms of the 'Love Our Home, Treasure Our Country' experience, cultivating and strengthening their national identity.

To ignite the primary students' passion for STEM, our student ambassadors introduced to them 3D-printing, drone engineering, science experiments and equipped the visitors with the know-how of STEM applications, transforming them into tech-savvy young scientists.

English session held at the English room proved equally fruitful and awe-inspiring, with the primary students utilizing their creativity and linguistic abilities to discuss and dissect the ethical considerations of harnessing the power of Al and robotics.



### 學生活動後咸想

#### 3A 陳諾殷

我很高興能參加學校安排的「廣州及佛山交流團」活動。在這次活動中,我對粵劇、陶瓷以及廣東省的文化有了更深層的認識。以粵劇藝術博物館和廣東石灣陶瓷博物館為例,前者讓我認識到粵劇不同方面的特色,例如在妝造方面,我原本只是覺得角色的妝容很精緻,沒想到妝容的設計也十分講究,需要根據角色的特點來畫,不能隨意處理。

此外,在石灣陶瓷博物館中我見證了陶藝製作的精妙之處,無論大小的陶瓷作品都經過精雕細琢,每個圖案都能看出工匠花費的時間和心血,栩栩如生,完美詮釋了「陶土盈細琢磨,匠心獨運造乾坤」的理念。除此之外,我們還接觸到了廣東省的文化和古建築風格,雖然無法一一介紹,但每一部分都讓我感受到廣東文化的博大精深,並激發了我對探究更多領域知識的興趣。

#### 3C 盧思官

這次的交流團雖然只有短短兩天,卻令我受益匪淺。

在參觀了多個博物館後,我對客家文化、粵劇發展和陶 瓷工藝等有了深入了解。其中,我對廣東省博物館尤感興 趣。館內的陳列品琳琅滿目,令人驚嘆,從龍舟到動物的牙 齒,甚至連皇后的鳳冠和皇帝的詔書都珍藏於此。這些文物 共同蘊藏著豐富而珍貴的知識。看見那些歷史文物,尤其是 粵劇劇本手稿,更使我聯想到老師在中文課堂上教授的《人 間有情》。實體展品讓我更容易理解早期劇本的結構,將抽 象的知識形象化。此外,我也明白了知識的展現並不僅限於 書本,還可以透過其他形式來表達和理解。

另外,學校安排的小組報告和分享環節,讓我們能夠互相交流學習心得,促進了團隊合作的精神。我相信通過這次 文化交流活動,我們的溝通技巧也將有顯著提升。

經過此次研學之旅,我獲益良多,見識了許多中國傳統 文化的歷史文物,吸取了豐富的知識,了解了古代海上絲綢 之路的背景及石灣的傳統製陶工藝。這次交流團也讓我反思 保護歷史文物的重要性,深刻體會文化傳承的意義,並感受 到卓越的工匠精神,進一步增強了我對國民身份的認同。
